In each letter, you will 1. briefly summarize what you've read 2 . make claims about the text and support them with evidence and analysis and finally, 3. ask open questions about parts of the text you are curious about.

On the due date, you and your partner will exchange letters during class and on a separate sheet of paper, write a response back. If your partner is absent or does not have a letter for you to read, you will respond to one of the questions in your own letter. You are responsible for making sure you get both the letter and response you have written back from your partner by the end of the period.
